Novice Youth, Novice Amateur, 13 & under Youth, 14-18 Youth, Amateur, Select & Open Blue Ribbon Saddles for the winners – can only win ONE saddle per family & horse. See office for complete rules & rotation of awards. Small Fry All-Around also three places – special awards for this division.

Must show halter in your respective division(s) to qualify. (Small Fry excluded.)

AQHA Classes: \$15/judge/class

Small Fry: \$7.50/judge/class - 9 & under

If you have earned points in a novice class you are ineligible to show in the corresponding small fry class. (Example - points in NY Pleasure, cannot show in SF Pleasure.)

All Day Fees: \$50/division/judge - Open/Amateur/Youth

\$40/division/judge - Novice

\$25/judge - Small Fry

Office Charge: \$5.00/horse

AQHA Fees: \$3/horse/judge (drug & processing fees)

Warm Ups: \$10/horse/show - Trail Horses

\$10/horse/show - Fence Horses

Halter Futurity: \$250.00 per class - runs concurrently with AQHA class

100% of futurity entry fee jackpotted.

NSBA Classes: \$13/judge/class (2 sets of points) Dual Approved Classes

\$1000 Open 3-year-old WP - \$75.00 entry fee

All other NSBA Futurity classes - \$500 purse - \$50.00 entry fee
